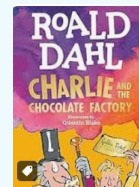

Reading

This term we will be reading Charlie and the Chocolate factory. We will be applying as many reading strategies as possible to our reading this term, including retrieval, predicting and inferring.



Writing

This term our focus text is 'Zeraffa Giraffa' by Dianne Hofmeyr. The story is based on a true story about a Giraffe from Egypt. As we read each part of the story, children will be focusing on persuasive writing. By the end of the term they will have written a non-fiction persuasive leaflet including present- perfect tense, second person, sub-coordinating conjunctions and alliteration to entice the reader to visit a local wildlife park.

Maths

Our Maths focuses in lessons this term will be money, shape and statistics. We will continue to also practice our times tables.

Project

Let's travel back 5000 years, to the dusty realms of ancient Egypt. Cruise along the Nile, entering a world of mysteries and curses, mummies and kings. Find out about life on the river's fertile banks, discovering Egypt and its fascinating culture. Unravel the secrets of ancient tombs, using historical sources and ancient artefacts.
