Reading

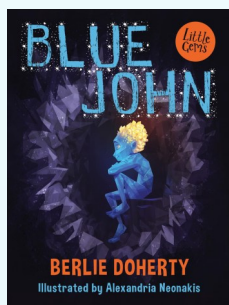
We will be reading Tutankhamun's Tomb by Sue Reid. We will find out about the discovery of the tomb in 1922. We will also be reading A Mummy Ate my Homework, finding out more about Ancient Egyptian life. We will use a range of reading strategies.



Writing

In our writing lessons we will be writing an explanation letter about cave formation based on the story Blue John by Berlie Doherty. We will also investigate and write a haiku in poetry.

We will continue to use basic punctuation accurately in our writing.



Maths

Our Maths focus in lessons this term will be converting time between a 12-hour and 24-hour clock, different types of angles in shapes as well as lines of symmetry, interpreting line graphs, plotting coordinates and translating shapes.

Topic

Term 6 is our 'Ancient Civilisations' topic where we will learn about the rise, life, achievements and eventual end of the ancient Sumer civilisation and compare it to the ancient Egyptian civilisation. We will also find out about the Indus Valley civilisation. Later in the term, we will be investigating simple machines including wheels, axles, incline planes and pulleys and levers.
